Talent

UNC Charlotte produces 6,000 graduates annually, led by engineering, tech and health sciences

UNC Charlotte's Oollege of Computing and Informatics, on of the largest in the country, graduates over 1,000 student s a year.

Varying by class, approximately 68% of UNC Charlotte graduates remain in Charlotte



Location

UNC Charlotte and its student population of 29,500 anchor the eastern edge of University City

A 2,200-acre business park hosting Fortune 500's anchors the western edge

Charlotte's 2nd largest employment center, six miles north of the CBD



Access

Light rail connects UNC Charlotte, Univeristy City, Uptown (CBD), South End and NoDa 107 times daily

Built aroungs todays busiest crossroad in the state (NC 29 and NC 49) with AADT exceeding 80,000

Access I-85, I-77 and I-485 in minutes



Housing

Homes in the 28269 zip code are forecast to appreciate by 5.1% in 2020, one of the highest rates in the region



An industrial corridor until light rail delivered there in 2008, now a millennial magnet and burgeoning office hub as businesses fight for the city's best talent.




The lake at the heart of University provides a scenic 1-mile walking loop, which connects to over 14-miles of contigious greenways and UNC Charlotte.
